Woombye State School will receive

\$162,159*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure quality teaching and learning strategies throughout school which assists all students in Years 3 and 5 to achieve and exceed National Minimum Standards (NMS) in NAPLAN Numeracy and Literacy during 2019.
- Provide support for all students in Prep to Year 4 to ensure students reach or exceed NMS in literacy.
- Provide student support programs in literacy and numeracy for students in all year levels who will not reach NMS.
- Maintain the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands achievement in Year 3 Reading and Writing at 50% or better, and improve the Upper Two Band Results in Year 5 Reading (39.0% to 50%) and Writing (1.6% to 30%).
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands achievement in Year 5 Spelling (18.0% to 40%).

Our initiatives include


- Provide support for students using Booster Reading Program.
- Support Writing (Just Write), Comprehension (Comprehend IT) and Maths (Solve IT) Programs for Middle School students.
- Review student performance data regularly.
- Provide teacher support for inclusive practices and unit planning each term.
- Provide teacher coaching/mentoring in unit planning and data interpretation.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing 3035 additional teacher aide hours to implement "Booster Reading Program", "Comprehend IT", "Just Write" and "Solve IT" for students across school. \$118 409
- Purchasing additional teacher time (0.8) to provide smaller class sizes in targeted year levels creating a better learning environment to meet the needs of individualised instruction and differentiated learning. Plan and implement differentiated integrated units catering for individual students. \$43 750
