Under this agreement for 2017 Woombye State School will receive

\$168,700*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure quality teaching and learning strategies throughout school which assists all students in Year 3 and Year 5 to achieve and exceed National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Numeracy and Literacy during 2017.
- Provide support for all students in Prep to Year 2 to ensure students reach or exceed NMS in Literacy.
- Provide student support programs in Literacy and Numeracy for students in all Year levels who will not reach NMS.
- Maintain the percentage of students in the U2B achievement in Year 3 Reading at 50% or better, and improve U2B achievement in Year 3 Writing (46% to 50%) and Year 5 Writing (13% to 30%).
- Increase the percentage of students in the U2B achievement in Year 3 and Year 5 in Spelling.

Our initiatives include


- Providing support for students using Booster Reading Program.
- Reviewing student performance data regularly.
- Providing teacher support for integrated unit planning each term.
- Providing teacher coaching/mentoring feedback each term.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing 3250 additional teacher aide hours to implement "Booster Reading Program" for students across school. | \$96,500 |
| • Purchasing 92 Teacher Relief Scheme days to release teachers to meet with Special Education Program Staff and Master Teacher each term to plan differentiated integrated units catering for individual students. | \$38,670 |
| • Acquiring additional resources to support enhancement of Literacy concepts, eg. Writing, Spelling. | \$33,540 |
