This funding will be used to

- Enhance and consolidate teacher knowledge and understanding of the CARF and CARP and the Three Levels of Planning.
- Continue to embed the use of the three levels of planning by providing term cohort planning days to deliver a consistent and uniformed approach to planning.
- Support individualising student needs (Inclusion policy) during planning and in classroom practices.
- To promote collaborative engagement between classroom teachers and SEU staff during planning and classroom practices to meet student needs.
- Enhance teacher pedagogical practices through 'Ways of Working', 'Learning Walks and Talks', and Teacher Profiling.
- Continue the improvement agenda in data literacies across the school.
- Continue the improvement in student learning outcomes in formative and summative assessment including NAPLAN, Pat M, and Pat R, Early Start, A-E achievements.

Our initiatives include

- Appointment of a Curriculum Leader (1.0) to lead and drive Curriculum knowledge, understanding and implementation.
- Creating a 'Digital Technologies role (0.6) to allow for teacher release for data discussions, curriculum conversations, 'WOW' release and other targeted initiatives.
- Creation of a Visual Arts position to provide teachers with 'targeted release time'.
- Engagement of SEU teachers in cohort planning days for effective differentiation planning and delivery of inclusive curriculum.
- Enhancing teacher knowledge, understanding and application of curriculum development (alignment with Australian Curriculum) and embedding effective planning and assessment practices.
- Provision of time for Case Management Meetings.
- Introducing and enhancing 'Third Teacher' spaces in all classrooms.
- The provision of teacher coaching/mentoring feedback regularly throughout the year to enhance pedagogical practices.


