- To enhance teacher understanding and knowledge of the Australian Curriculum
- To enhance teacher pedagogical practices
- To promote collaborative engagement throughout the school
- To improve data literacies across the school
- To ensure all curriculum learning units align with the Australian Curriculum V8
- To continue the improvement in student learning outcomes in formative and summative assessment. This includes NAPLAN, Pat Assessment in Mathematics and Comprehension, Early Start, A-E achievement.

Our initiatives include

- Monitoring, viewing and discussing student performance data (NAPLAN and PAT) weekly, termly and annually.
- Enhancing teacher knowledge and understanding for effective differentiation in the classroom.
- Enhancing teacher knowledge & understanding of curriculum development (alignment with Australian Curriculum v8) and embedding effective planning and assessment practices.
- Provide teacher coaching/mentoring feedback regularly throughout the year to enhance pedagogical practices.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Weekly targeted release time for general classroom teaching staff to work in collaboration (Curriculum Develop, differentiation (ICP, SSP, ISP, IBSP) & Data) - \$80 000
- Term Cohort Curriculum Development Days - \$42 000
- Focused Data Discussion Days with teaching staff and key stakeholders - \$6 000
- Implementation of Early Start Assessment - \$25 000
- Resources - \$11 248
